NW Loop Ramp Closure and Detour Begins Tuesday

CLARK COUNTY, NV. – The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) will open a new detour route for access from northbound US 95 to westbound CC 215 on Tuesday, February 5, 2019 at 5 am. NDOT will permanently close and subsequently begin removal of the old NW Loop Ramp that connects northbound US 95 to westbound CC 215 as part of the US 95 Northwest Corridor Improvement Project.

A detour will be made available to the travelling public and signed appropriately. Commuters will exit northbound US 95 approximately 1,000 feet south of the old NW Loop Ramp and continue north on the detour to the intersection of Sky Pointe Drive and CC 215. Motorists will need to stop at the traffic signal before turning westbound on CC 215.

This ramp detour is required to accommodate construction for the new north to west flyover ramp, and will remain in effect until the completion of the ramp in the fall of 2020. Commuters are encouraged to exercise extra precaution throughout the duration of the project.
